

Electrical Safety: Extension Cords & more

Extension Cords are for temporary use ONLY. If you need additional outlets, contact Facilities.



Never use frayed or damaged cords




Never plug an extension cord into another extension cord or overload the cord





Consult equipment manuals. Never exceed extension cord length or amperage ratings.





Only use extension cords that are NRTL approved. "CE" ratings are not recognized.





Never modify plugs by removing the grounding pins or using 2-prong adapters.

Never run extension cords or power strips above drop ceilings or through walls.



Electrical cords must be secured and protected from abrasion when in walkways.
